RECORD STARTER DESIGNATED START TIME _____ MIN _____ SEC
(When starter is ready to tell band to begin set-up - must not be before scheduled time unless director ok's)

RECORD ACTUAL BAND START TIME _____ MIN _____ SEC
(If band is not present at starting line through its own fault or refuses to move in a timely manner to enter the Competition Area to begin set-up when told to do so, DELAY IN START TIME (IF ANY) _____ MIN _____ SEC

START TIME PENALTY
x 0.5 per each min or fraction thereof - (Penalty only applies if band is late to starting point through their own fault or refuses to enter the Competition Area in a timely fashion when told to do so by the starter. Penalty is waived if show time starts within 4 minutes of starter designated start time or if total performance time is _____)

RECORD WHEN SHOW TIME BEGINS _____ MIN _____ SEC
(Same as actual Band Start Time above - usually the same as the Designated Start Time).

RECORD WHEN SHOW TIME ENDS _____ MIN _____ SEC
(Band leaves field or clears exit line)

TOTAL SHOW TIME _____ MIN _____ SEC

SHOW TIMING PENALTY
x 0.1 for every 3 seconds over 15 minutes unless band has cleared field and is on way to exit line. Then one additional minute is permitted without penalty.

RECORD WHEN PERFORMANCE TIME BEGINS _____ MIN _____ SEC
(First note of music or first movement - No later than 4 minutes after Start Time)

RECORD WHEN PERFORMANCE TIME ENDS _____ MIN _____ SEC
(Last note of music, last performer movement, or Drum Major Closing Salute)

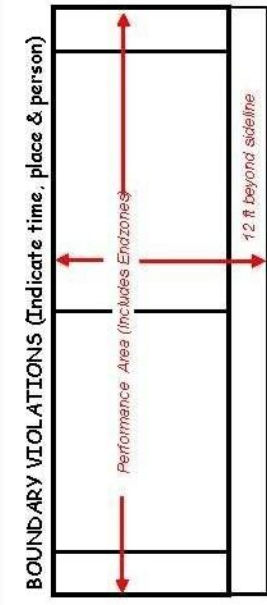

PERFORMANCE TIMING PENALTY
x 0.1 for every 3 seconds under 7 minutes or over 11 minutes,

RECORD TOTAL NUMBER OF WIND PLAYERS _____ WIND PLAYERS

1A = 1-30 3A = 45-64 5A = 85 and up
2A = 31-44 4A = 65-84 Show Band = No limit

CLASSIFICATION PENALTY
x 0.5 for every wind player under the allowable quantity and/or for each player over if potential simultaneous wind players (players with instruments) at any point in the show is over the allowable quantity.



BOUNDARY VIOLATION PENALTY
x 0.1 for each infraction. Boundary of Performance Area is 12 ft inside the front side-line from goal to goal. All Band Members (except Drum Majors) must be in and remain in the performance area until the end of the show. Only Drum Majors can cross boundary lines. (Brief entry of Authorized Non-Performing Personnel to adjust electronics (2x max - See below) or pick up dropped equipment that could be a hazard to performing members is permitted). Non-performing Personnel may never move or adjust props.

OTHER VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES

ELECTRONICS (Others may adjust levels maximum of two times during the show) _____ 0.5 and up at discretion

CONDUCTING/CUING BAND (Others may not cue or direct from stands or sidelines) _____ 0.5 per incident

PERFORMING OUT OF SEQUENCE (Band does not report to show on time) _____ 1.0 per each placement

FLAG CODE VIOLATIONS (Per Title 4 of US Flag Code) _____ 0.1 point per infraction

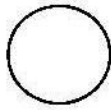
